



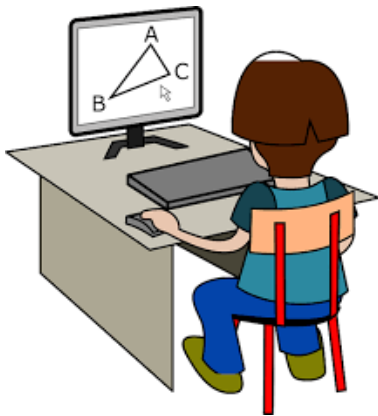
Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,
